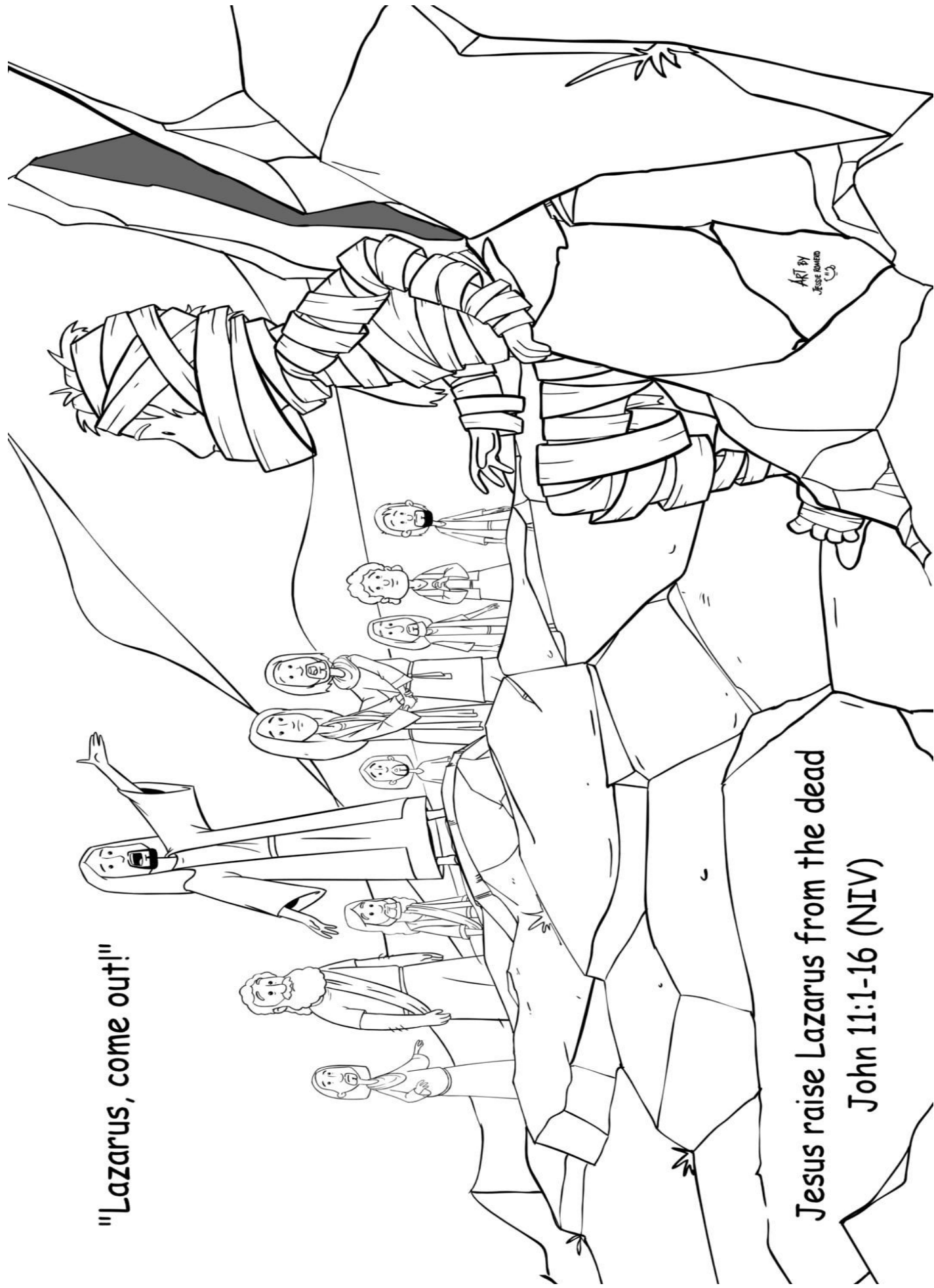
### FAMILY ACTIVITY:
